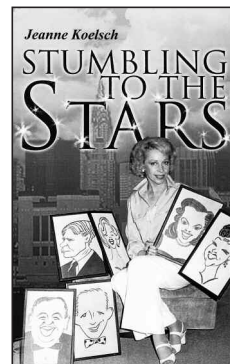


Her Story Sounds Like a Blockbuster Film!
